School Entry Requirements per:

- 1 Delaware Code, Title 14, Section 131
- 2 Department of Education Regulation 804
- 3 Department of Education Regulation 805
- 4 Delaware Code, Title 16, Chapter 26

According to Delaware laws and Department of Education regulations, all children entering school for the first time are required to have proof on file of the following:

Immunizations¹:

- 5 or more doses of DTaP, DTP or TD vaccine (unless 4th dose was given after the 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of IPV or OPV (unless the 3rd dose was given after the 4th birthday)
- 2 doses of measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (first dose after the age of 12 months, second dose after the 4th birthday)
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
- 1 dose of Varicella or a written disease history (**05/06 School Year: Grades K-2, 06/07 School Year: Grades K-3; 07/08 School Year: Grades K-4; etc.)**)

Physical²:

Current, within the two years prior to entry into school

Tuberculosis³:

Results of Mantoux screening completed within the past 12 months or risk assessment as recommended by Delaware Division of Public Health

Lead blood test⁴ (First time School Entry)

Documentation for children entering kindergarten or pre-school program
