

## **Student Code of Conduct – Virtual Learning Addendum**

### **I. Purpose:**

- a. The purpose of this addendum is to ensure that there are clear expectations and guidelines for students when learning in a virtual setting.

### **II. Addendum Statement:**

- a. Students are expected to follow the same Code of Conduct rules in the virtual setting as they would during in-person instruction except for uniforms.
  - i. This includes the prohibition of cellphones and violations of privacy for any student or staff.
  - ii. Students are expected to wear clothing that would appropriate for NUT (No Uniform Today) day during virtual instruction.
- b. While conducting school through the virtual setting (including teacher lessons and classwork), students are prohibited from doing the following at any time -
  - i. Duplicating the material and lesson
  - ii. Recording the lesson
  - iii. Taking pictures/screenshots of the material or lesson
- c. Students are required to have video function turned on during virtual lessons at the direction of the teacher.

### **III. Responsibility:**

- a. This Addendum works in conjunction with the Student Code of Conduct. All students are required to follow the provisions above. Any violations may result in disciplinary action.
