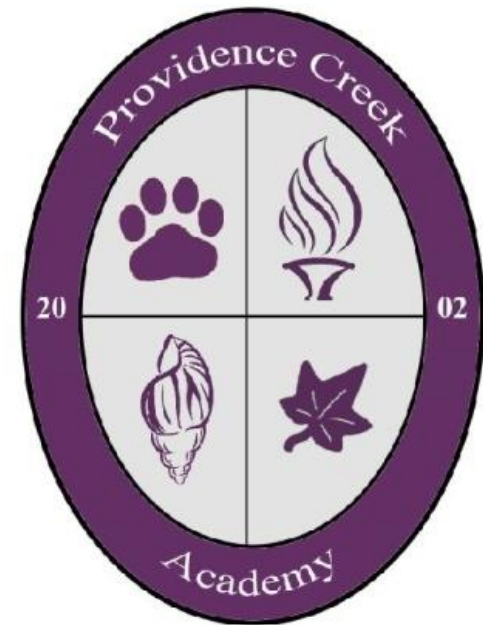


PROVIDENCE CREEK ACADEMY RE-OPENING

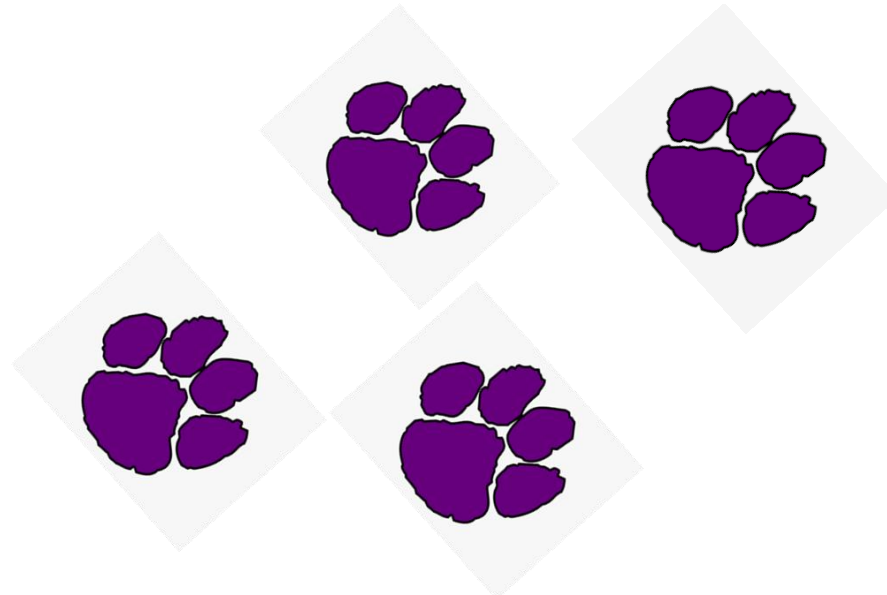

IN-PERSON PLAN

- PCA is prepared to have a full opening for the 2021-2022 school year, if state guidelines permit.
- All staff and students will attend school in person every school day.
 - Medically compromised students and those with a doctor's excuse will still be offered alternative learning options.



IN-PERSON SAFETY PLAN

GENERAL GUIDANCE



- All current DPH Guidelines will be adhered to for social distancing, masking, cleaning, etc.
 - All staff and students in grades K-8 will continue to wear face coverings inside/outside the school building, and on busses except when doing so would inhibit the individual's health until DPH/CDC no longer requires this for school settings.
 - Students will be required to wash their hands prior to all meals and to wash hands or utilize hand sanitizer frequently throughout the day.
 - All high touch areas will be sanitized frequently throughout the day using EPA approved tools and solutions.
 - Students will not be permitted to share classroom items unless they have been sanitized after each use.

GENERAL GUIDANCE



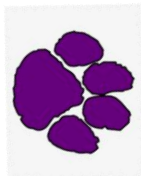
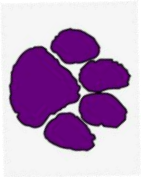
- Hallways will be marked to indicate flow of traffic and social distancing demarcations.
- Water fountains will not be available. Students will continue to bring their own water or teachers will have water bottles available.
- All PCA faculty and students will follow social distancing per current guidelines while in and on school property.
- Additional spaces such as the gym, technology lab, outdoor spaces, and auditorium will be utilized for meals to maintain distancing guidelines.

HEALTH AND WELLNESS

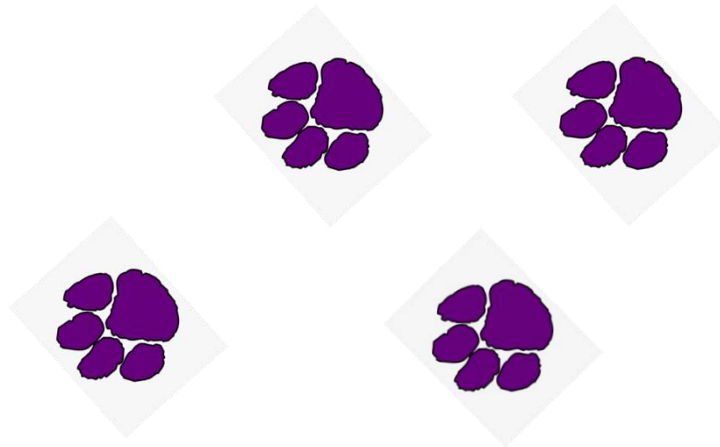
- PCA families and staff are to complete the current DPH Health Assessment every morning before leaving for school.
- The PCA nurse's office has separate areas where students and staff members who become ill at school can wait until they can be picked up, which should be arranged as soon as possible, or transported to a medical facility if necessary.
- Any positive/possible COVID cases and exposures will be sent home and offered homebound instruction based on PCA policies.
 - Dates will be determined by the school nurse in conjunction with DPH and current guidelines.

TRANSPORTATION

- Parents will again be asked (when able) to transport their students to and from school for the 2021-2022 school year, ensuring we are able to meet all current guidelines.
- Bus Riders will be distanced per current guidance.
 - Busses will continue to be cleaned before and after each route.
 - Assigned seating for bus riders will continue.
 - Hand sanitizer will be offered when entering and exiting bus.
